

**COMMISSIONERS COURT ORDER**

WHEREAS, on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2024 the County Judge declared a state of local disaster for San Jacinto County resulting from extreme flooding, which was extended by the County Judge in accordance with the Texas Government Code 418.108.

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating declaration of a state of disaster continue to exist; and


WHEREAS, 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code provides that a local state of disaster may not be continued or renewed for a period of more than seven days except with the consent of the governing body of the political subdivision;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF San Jacinto County:

1. That the State of disaster proclaimed for the County of San Jacinto by the County Judge on 6<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2024 shall continue until terminated by order of the COMMISSIONERS COURT.
2. This ordinance is passed as an emergency measure and pursuant to local authority for emergency measures and shall become effective on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2024.
